

Meeting of the Bombay Town Board

April 8, 2026

Meeting was called to order by Deputy Supervisor Mike Kelley as Supervisor Chris Jock was absent. Present were Town Board members Sarah Devlin, Erin Gray, and Jenelle Niles. Supt. Of Highways Pat Mayer was also present.

- I. **Minutes** – Jenelle motions to approve the minutes from the previous meeting as read by the clerk. Motion is seconded by Erin Gray. All voted “Aye”, motion carried.
- II. **Insurance Proposal** – Jessica Burditt from One Group presented a NYMIR renewal insurance proposal in the amount of \$37,227.40 which is an increase of 2.20% over 2025.
- III. **Mowing** – Proposals will be accepted until April 22nd and opened at 6:00p.m.
- IV. **Retirement** – Erin motions to approve the standard workday resolution for retirement for the first quarter of 2026. Motion is seconded by Sarah. All voted “Aye”, motion carried.
- V. **Franklin County Tourism Grant** – An application has been submitted for \$5000 to purchase tables and chairs for the rec park pavilion. The Town would have to spend at least that amount to be eligible for the 50% match. The Town cannot purchase anything until the grant is approved. Board questions if racks for storage are eligible.
- VI. **Walking Trail** – Estimates needed for paving
- VII. **Park** – Board questions the pond at park
- VIII. **Brown Property** – Franklin County is expected to pass a resolution this month authorizing the transfer of the Brown property on Route 95 to the Town in the amount of \$5500.
- IX. **Insurance** – Sarah motions to renew the NYMIR insurance policy with One Group, with option #1 pertaining to cyber coverage, seconded by Erin. All voted “Aye”, motion carried.
- X. **Monthly Reports** - The Board expects monthly reports from the code officer, dog control officer, and assessor.
- XI. **Highway Report-**
 - Man door replaced at garage
 - Repairs done on 2015 dump
 - Chipping continues on Kibbie Rd
 - Moved sand & salt
 - Questions about the Town’s responsibility regarding driveway culverts
 - Monthly mileage and fuel report submitted
- XII. **Executive Session** – Mike motions to enter executive session at 7:30p.m. for the purpose of discussing personnel issues. Seconded by Erin. All voted “Aye”, motion carried. Session was closed at 7:45p.m
