

Meeting of the Bombay Town Board

June 10, 2026

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Jock. Present were Board members Mike Kelley, Sarah Devlin, and Jenelle Niles. Erin Gray was absent. Also present was Supt. Of Highways, Pat Mayer.

- I. **Minutes** – Mike motions to approve the minutes from the previous meeting as read by the clerk, seconded by Sarah. All voted “Aye”, motion carried.
- II. **Historical Society Update** – New tin roof is complete; cost was approx. \$1900.
- III. **Get Healthy North Country** – Classes at Community Center are complete, the Town was sent a check for \$2800 for participation.
- IV. **FEMA Flood Maps**- maps have been received and are available for inspection.
- V. **Table & Chair Grant** – Board agrees to give away the cafeteria style tables at the pavilion. Chris has ordered and received tables (32) & chairs (178). He will also order chair rollers.
- VI. **Playground Equipment** – Discussion about different options that have been seen at other playgrounds (culvert, tires, sand).
- VII. **Code Officer Report** – 3 inspections, 4 site visits and 2 violations.
- VIII. **Park** – Board decides that the “pond” will be tiled, filled in and mowed.
- IX. **Highway Report**
 - Working on Cotter Road
 - Having difficulty securing salt orders
 - Monthly mileage and fuel report submitted
 - Traveled to Rochester to view the Roller (\$14,500). Offered the trailer to haul it for \$12,000 and offered a Paver for \$17,000. Trucking would be included and trade old trailer. Board requests that Pat check if a deal can be made for the Roller and Trailer only. Willing to trade old trailer in exchange.
 - Total CHIPS, PAVE NY, EWR, and POP monies for the 2026-27 is expected to be 248,287.64 including rollover balance.
- X. **Executive Session** – Mike motions to enter executive session at 7:50p.m. to discuss personnel matters, seconded by Jenelle. All voted “Aye”, motion carried. Session was closed at 8:20p.m.
