

## Meeting of the Bombay Town Board

July 11, 2018

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Taylor. All Council members were present as well as Highway Supt, Jamie Durant and Code Officer/Assessor, Robert Rowe.

- I. **Minutes** – Jacque motions to accept minutes from previous meeting as read, seconded by Mike. All voted “Aye”, motion carried.
- II. **Highway Report** –
  1. Solar Speed sign has been repaired
  2. Paving has been started on Cold Springs Road
  3. Laware started the remaining pave job at park on July 11<sup>th</sup>
  4. Bleachers for park have been received
  5. New flags are being put up; will come down after Labor Day.
  6. Jay Ingalls has started digging at park and will come back when bleachers are in to help with site work
  7. The Cty Hwy Dept. will stop paving Cty Rt 4 just after the bridge before solar speed sign until next year.
  8. Everything on Auctions Int’l sold except the International.
  9. Chicken Pit has not been cleaned since Fire Dept used it in June and garbage was left behind from Field Day.
- III. **Bombay Historical Society Lease** – Supervisor Taylor will forward a previous lease to Dick Edwards for consideration. The BHS will need to give the Board input on what they expect.
- IV. **Code/Assessor Report** – Bob explains that the cost of permits for commercial repairs/renovations hasn’t been addressed. He will work on price list for Board consideration.
- V. **Recycling** – A resident approached Chris Jock about the possibility of the Town maintaining a recycling station or bin that would be available for residents. Chris will check out some options and prices for Board consideration.
- VI. **2019 Budget** – Jacque wants to prioritize new Highway Garage.
