

Meeting of the Bombay Town Board

May 14, 2025

Public Hearing

A public hearing for the purpose of public comment regarding local law #01 of 2025 was called to order at 5:45 p.m. by Supervisor Jock. All Town Board members were present. Local Law #01 is a local law to abolish the office of tax collector in the Town of Bombay. No public comments were made. The hearing was closed at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Jock.

Regular Meeting

Supervisor Jock called the regular monthly town board meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. All town board members were present as well as Pat Mayer, Supt. of Highways.

- I. **Minutes** – Sarah motions to accept the minutes from the previous meeting as read by the clerk, seconded by Erin. All voted “Aye”, motion carried.
- II. **Community Center Internet** – Spectrum will be coming soon; town needs to purchase a router. 3 months of service will be free. Chris will also look into a phone system for the municipal offices.
- III. **Corner Lot Park** - Flowers from Val’s Country Creations will be planted by volunteers.
- IV. **Local Law #01 of 2025** – Mike motions to pass the local law abolishing the office of tax collector, seconded by Chad. The law is subject to mandatory referendum and a proposition will be on the November ballot.
- V. **Highway Report:**
 1. Plows are off trucks
 2. Salt is ready for fall/winter
 3. Road posted signs are down
 4. Ditching and working on culverts on Kibbie & Broad Road
 5. Checking into replacing culverts on Cold Springs Road between Route 95 and railroad tracks.
 6. Checking into prices on grinding and blacktopping on Cold Springs Road between Route 95 and the railroad tracks.
 7. Flags will be ordered and placed on light poles.
 8. Fuel and mileage report submitted
