

Meeting of the Bombay Town Board

June 11, 2025

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Jock. All Town Board members were present as well as Superintendent of Highways, Pat Mayer.

- I. **Minutes** – Mike motions to accept the minutes from the previous meeting as read, seconded by Erin. All voted “Aye”, motion carried.
- II. **Community Center Internet** – Installation through Spectrum is complete.
- III. **Food Pantry Agreement** – Current agreement expires in June 2025. Chad introduces the following text for a new agreement:

This is a space use agreement between the Town of Bombay and the Bombay Food Pantry. This agreement shall cover the use of the building located at 24 County Route 4, Bombay, NY 12914.

The Town of Bombay agrees to provide the use of the building (including kitchen & bathrooms) and will provide general building maintenance, snow removal of the parking area and lawn care. The Town of Bombay reserves the right to access portions of the building as needed (kitchen & bathrooms).

The Town of Bombay will provide tables, chairs, and storage space for food. Utilities for refrigerators and freezers will be provided by the town. Lighting, heating, and air conditioning will also be provided by the town.

The Town of Bombay will provide assistance with food pickup and delivery when assistance is available.

The Town of Bombay requests \$_____ for the use of the building and utilities.

This agreement shall be in effect from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026.

Sarah seconds the motion. All voted “Aye”, motion carried.

- IV. **Ballot Proposition Resolution** – Supervisor Jock offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Bombay has duly adopted a Local Law, which directs that the same be submitted for the approval of the electors at the next general election of the Town of Bombay;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the following question be placed on the ballot and voted upon in the next general election of the Town of Bombay:

“Shall the Local Law, entitled ‘Local Law No. 1 of 2025 “A Local Law to Abolish the Office of Tax Collector for the Town of Bombay”’ abolishing the Office of the Tax Collector for the Town of Bombay after the expiration of the Office’s term on December 31, 2025 and transferring the powers and duties of the Office of the Tax Collector to the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Bombay be approved?”

And be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Bombay directs that the Town of Bombay Town Clerk send to the Franklin County Board of Elections the aforesaid question with a request that the same be placed on the ballot of the Town of Bombay and voted upon at the next general election, to be held on November 4, 2025.

Motion is seconded by Mike, all voted “Aye”, motion carried.
