

Meeting of the Bombay Town Board

August 13, 2025

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Jock. Council members Mike Kelley and Chad Bryant were present. Erin Gray and Sarah Devlin were absent. Also present was Supt. of Highways, Patrick Mayer.

- I. **Community Development Block Grant** – Shane Chatelle from AEDA presented information about a grant available for upgrading the Community Center and ADA compliance. Grant application is due by October 31, 2025. A public hearing will be held September 17th at 6:00 p.m.
- II. **Board of Assessment Review** – The Town has an opening for a BAR member that needs to be filled. The Assessor's term ends in September and he is interested in re-appointment.
- III. **Park lawn mower** – Quotes were received from Mullarney's and United AG for zero turn gas powered mowers. Mike motions to purchase a mower from Mullarney's in the amount of \$5396, seconded by Chad. All voted "Aye", motion carried.
- IV. **Roadside Mower** – Three quotes from Dagoon's, Tracey Road Equipment, and United Ag were obtained. Mike motions to purchase a new John Deere FC10R Flex Wing Rotary Cutter from United Ag (subtotal \$24,145.20) and to purchase the following standard options- Torsional Suspension (subtotal \$1,882.52) and 6 Foam-Filled Tires (subtotal \$654.36) for a total price of \$26,682.08. Motion is seconded by Chad. All voted "Aye", motion carried.
- V. **Highway Excavator** – The Board requests that the Highway Supt. solicit at least 3 quotes.
- VI. **Bill Payments** – The Board approved the following bills for payment:
