Public Hearings

Regular Meeting

- II. **Town Budget** – Sarah motions to pass the 2026 Town Budget. The amount to be raised by taxes will be \$381,813.00. The motion is seconded by Erin. All voted “Aye”, motion carried.
- III. **Fire Department Contracts** – Erin motions to accept the contracts. Bombay Fire Department will receive \$52,000 for 2026 and the Hogansburg Fire Department will receive \$3,000. Sarah seconds the motions, all voted “Aye”, motion carried.
- IV. **Data Collection** – Erin motions to contract with Angela Lucey for data collection in the amount of \$20/parcel. Motion is seconded by Sarah. All voted “Aye”, motion carried.
- V. **Highway Report** –
